

**Criteria to meet GSBA Standards for Local Boards of Education and Board of Distinction Classification**

<b>Standards for Local Boards of Education</b>	<b>Board of Distinction Classification</b>
a. BOE adopts and submits "Form to Begin the Standards Process."	a. BOE and system are not on probation from SACS/CASI or any other accreditation organization.
b. BOE appoints a local committee to complete the Standards Checklist and report findings to board.	b. Must have met criteria of Standards for Local Boards of Education.
c. BOE reviews, adopts and develops corrective action plans for areas of improvement identified by local committee, if applicable.	c. Implement GSBA Board/Leadership Team Self-Assessment Checklist <i>(Revised in 2007)</i> .
d. BOE submits "Form to Verify Compliance with the Standards" to GSBA along with a copy of the completed Standards Checklist and any corrective action plans adopted by the BOE, if applicable.	d. Formalize superintendent evaluation incorporating district goals.
e. BOE submits "Form to Recertify Compliance with the Standards for a Local Board of Education" to GSBA every two years.	e. A copy of, or a web link to, the board's goal-setting model and listing of district's goals.
	f. A web link to posting of monthly board meeting agendas online.
	g. A web link to the local district's policy manual that is posted on the Internet.
	h. A plan for technology integration at the school board governance level of the local district. This refers to school board members and how the board is integrating technology in their governance operations.
	i. Signature on "Form to Begin Board of Distinction Process."
	j. Complete "Form to Verify Compliance with Board of Distinction." <i>(Submit with supporting materials.)</i>
	k. Every two years the BOE completes and submits to GSBA the "Form to Recertify Compliance with Board of Distinction."
